### GENERAL

Encana Corporation is the owner and operator of the Deep Panuke natural gas field in Nova Scotia's offshore. The project includes facilities required to produce natural gas from the Deep Panuke field, located approximately 175 kilometers offshore Nova Scotia. Natural gas from Deep Panuke is processed offshore at the Production Field Centre (PFC) with sales gas transported to market via a subsea pipeline making landfall at Guysborough County, NS. The PFC is located approximately 250 km southeast of Halifax.

Encana is committed to providing opportunities for Nova Scotian and Canadian companies through employment, procurement and contracting on an internationally competitive basis, with full and fair opportunity for Nova Scotians and Canadians where competitive on a best value basis, and first consideration to Nova Scotians. Interested firms are requested to demonstrate their capabilities and experience via a formal response to this EOI and the Prequalification Questionnaire, which can be obtained from Encana at the address provided below.

### Scope of Work

Encana is seeking interested firms for the provision of marine gas oil (MGO) and low sulphur diesel (LSD) for its Deep Panuke offshore operations and its Well Plug and Abandonment Program. The MGO will be required for offshore support vessels as well as a jack-up drilling rig on an as-required, 24-hours-per-day, 7-days-per-week basis. Approximate consumption of MGO is 4,500 cubic metres per year in support of operations and an additional 5,000 cubic metres commencing in Q4 2019 / Q1 2020 for the drilling rig and its anchor handling vessels.

This is an estimate only and does not imply a minimum or maximum quantity. Preferred product delivery is at the supplier's dock facility or via barge, truck or rail car.

Any contract resulting from this EOI is estimated to be awarded in March, 2019. The supplier must comply with all laws, regulations and orders applicable to storage, handling, transportation, and delivery of products.

## **Requirements**

1. Interested parties are required to have an EH&S Management System and a registered Quality Management System and a current certificate issued by a recognized third party that certifies that the Quality Management System meets the requirements of the ISO 9001.
2. All work carried out for Deep Panuke shall comply fully with Canada-Nova Scotia Offshore Petroleum Board Regulations.
3. Contractors shall have previous experience with carrying out the work similar to that specified by this EOI.

## **Information Requested with EOI response**

Respondents are requested to provide a brief Company profile, contact details, key personnel and a summary of related experience including Nova Scotia and Canadian capabilities and all data pertinent to the scope of work.

Encana will select qualified bidders using the responses to this EOI as a guide. Any eventual list of Bidders will be posted on the Encana website and other industry websites such as BIDS Nova Scotia. Encana reserves the right to select more than one Contractor to execute the above Scope of Work.

Encana is under no obligation to proceed with a Request for Proposal or Quote as a result of this call for Expressions of Interest. Respondents that qualify will be invited to participate in the event Proposals or Quotes are solicited.

Expressions of Interest must be received electronically on or before **January 17, 2019** at 2:00 PM Atlantic time.
