### EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI): Marine Warranty Surveyor

#### GENERAL

Encana Corporation is the owner and operator of the Deep Panuke natural gas field in Nova Scotia's offshore. The project includes facilities required to produce natural gas from the Deep Panuke field, located approximately 175 kilometers offshore Nova Scotia. Production ceased in May 2018 and Encana is proceeding with project decommissioning with field operations expected from 2019 to approximately 2021.

Natural gas from Deep Panuke was processed offshore at the Production Field Centre (PFC) with sales gas transported to market via a subsea pipeline making landfall at Goldboro, NS. The PFC is located approximately 250 km southeast of Halifax. Other project infrastructure includes the following:

- Five (5) - subsea wells, trees, and protection structures;
- Infield subsea flowlines and umbilicals; and
- Subsea gas export pipeline (GEP) and onshore metering facility at Goldboro.

#### Business Opportunities

Encana is committed to providing opportunities for Nova Scotian and Canadian companies through employment, procurement and contracting on an internationally competitive basis, with full and fair opportunity for Nova Scotians and Canadians where competitive on a best value basis, and first consideration to Nova Scotians. Pre-qualified companies will be required to complete a Canada-Nova Scotia Benefits Questionnaire and demonstrate their commitment to and compliance with Encana's requirements regarding Canada-Nova Scotia Benefits, during the tender process.

Interested firms are requested to demonstrate their capabilities and experience via a formal response to this EOI and the Prequalification Questionnaire, which can be obtained from Encana at the address provided below.

#### Scope of Work

Encana is seeking to pre-qualify experienced contractors for the purpose of coordinating and providing Marine Warranty Surveyor services for the decommissioning project.

The Marine Warranty Surveyor Services scope of work covers the removal and inshore transport of the following Deep Panuke assets which are being decommissioned:

- Sections of subsea Flowline, subsea Gas Export Pipeline, and subsea Umbilicals;

- Production Field Centre (PFC);
- Subsea Wellhead Protection Structures (WHPS); and
- Subsea Isolation Valve (SSIV) Structure.

The Marine Warranty Surveyor will be responsible for review and/or approval of certain procedures related to Project work, attendance at certain activities and in some cases issuance of certificates and reports related to a specific scope of work on the Project. The Marine Warranty Surveyor nominated for the Project must be from an internationally recognized organization that is acceptable to the Project's insurance underwriters.

Contractor will be required to provide qualified and competent Marine Warranty Surveyor personnel, including coordination support, at the required times and locations.

The above work scope is anticipated to cover the locations and timelines as listed herein. To provide these services, Respondents shall have experienced personnel to perform all aspects of the Work. Respondents shall have demonstrated capability in the execution and completion of such projects in a timely and cost effective manner.

Any contract resulting from this EOI is estimated to be awarded in April, 2019. The contractor must comply with all laws, regulations and orders applicable to the work.

## **Requirements**

1. Interested parties are required to have an EH&S Management System and a registered Quality Management System and a current certificate issued by a recognized third party that certifies that the Quality Management System meets the requirements of the ISO 9001.
2. All work carried out for Deep Panuke shall comply fully with Canada-Nova Scotia Offshore Petroleum Board Regulations.
3. Contractors shall have previous experience with carrying out the work similar to that specified by this EOI.

## **Information Requested with EOI response**

Respondents are requested to provide a brief company profile, contact details, key personnel and a summary of related experience including Nova Scotia and Canadian capabilities and all data pertinent to the scope of work.

Encana will select qualified bidders using the responses to this EOI as a guide. Any eventual list of Bidders will be posted on the Encana website and other industry websites such as BIDS Nova Scotia. Encana reserves the right to select more than one Contractor to execute the above Scope of Work.

Encana is under no obligation to proceed with a Request for Proposal or Quote as a result of this call for Expressions of Interest. Respondents that qualify will be invited to participate in the event Proposals or Quotes are solicited.

Expressions of Interest must be received electronically on or before **February 12, 2019** at 2:00 PM Atlantic time.
