#### **GENERAL**

SBM Nova Scotia Contractors Inc. (SBM NS) operates the Production Field Centre (PFC) for the Deep Panuke field on behalf of Encana Corporation.

The PFC, which contains all of the main natural gas processing facilities, is located approximately 250 km southeast of Halifax, Nova Scotia, Canada approximately 47 km west of Sable Island and in approximately 47 metres water depth.

Respondents are advised that work carried out on Deep Panuke shall comply fully with all applicable regulatory requirements. Respondents shall also be required to comply with the Canada Nova Scotia Offshore Petroleum Resources Accord Implementation Acts including but not limited to the Benefits requirements as set out in Section 45.

SBM NS is committed to providing opportunities for Nova Scotian and Canadian companies through employment, procurement and contracting on an internationally competitive basis, with full and fair opportunity for Nova Scotians and Canadians, and first consideration to Nova Scotians where competitive on a best value basis. Pre-qualified companies will be required to complete a Canada-Nova Scotia Benefits Questionnaire and demonstrate their commitment to and compliance with the Canada-Nova Scotia Benefits requirements, during the tender process.

### SCOPE OF WORK

SBM Nova Scotia Contractors Inc is requesting quotations for the supply all labor, materials and consumables to fabricate, NDE, hydro test and coat piping spools and associated supports for the following items:

- Package 1 includes fabrication of approximately 13 meters of 8" Schedule 40 Process Gas (PG) pipework and associated supports.
- Package 2 includes for an additional 23 meters of 8" Schedule 40 Seawater (SW) pipework and associated supports.

Note: Valves, pressure gauge, studs and gaskets for installation offshore are not included in this requirement.

Respondents to this RFQ must have current, qualified welding procedures, and welders qualified to those procedures, for the type and size of pipe being fabricated under this RFQ.

### PROJECT SCHEDULE

All work required under this Scope must be completed and the pipe spools delivered to SBM for transport to the Deep Panuke PFC no later than May 8, 2019.
