GENERAL

DOF Subsea Canada Corp (DOF) hereby invites interested parties to submit an Expression of Interest (EOI) and complete the Prequalification in connection with DOFs Removal of Subsea Structures, Transport & Disposal Scope of Work as part of the Deep Panuke Project on behalf of Encana Corporation in Nova Scotia, Canada.

SCOPE OF WORK

DOF Subsea requires the provision of dismantle & disposal services for several subsea infrastructure components.

Subcontractors scope of work will be as follows:

- Provision of suitable guayside with:
 - Priority access berthage with appropriate bollard capacity with minimum 8.0m water depth at LAT for a 8000GRT construction vessel.
 - Conformity with the International Ships and Port Security (ISPS)
 - Sufficient storage / laydown capacity to support multiple offshore trips / operations
 - Office space with sufficient power and amenities for Client personnel overseeing operations
 - Facility and qualified experienced personnel to perform the following services:
 - Stevedoring services
 - On site potable water
 - Inside office and welfare facility
 - On site safety personnel services
- Transportation of subsea infrastructure from the quayside to dismantling location.
- Dismantling and recycling / disposal of steelwork from 6 off structures (tubular diameters ranging from 219.1mm to 914mm. Wall thickness ranging from 5.8mm to 38.1mm). Structures will also contain a variety of structural member, small bore tubing, steel plate, etc.
- Dismantling and recycling / disposal of steelwork from 1 off 24" ball valve complete with 2 off 22" pipe spools ends
 located within above structure
- Dismantling and recycling / disposal of steelwork from 5 off wellheads (wellhead components consist of 30" conductor, LP&HP housing, 13.375" casing and 9.625" casing)
